**ORDER**

**SARAH L. CAVE**, United States Magistrate Judge.

Defendant Milad Oskouie's request for a two-month extension of time to obtain an attorney (ECF No. 187) is GRANTED. Mr. Oskouie is reminded that he cannot represent the entity defendants and counter-claimants, Osko M Ltd. and Platinum Avenue Holdings Pty, Ltd (the "Entity Parties"). The Entity Parties must appear through counsel or risk an entry of default against them. The Court has been lenient with Mr. Oskouie's timeline to obtain an attorney, but given the two-year pendency of this action and the Honorable Ronnie Abrams' Order, a year and a half ago, directing him to obtain new counsel or inform the Court that he is proceeding pro se (ECF No. 169), this will be Mr. Oskouie's final extension of time to obtain an attorney.

If an attorney does not enter an appearance on behalf of the Entity Parties by **Monday, May 4, 2020**, Plaintiff may seek a certificate of default from the Clerk of Court. As a follow-up to the Telephone Conference held on Tuesday, January 28, 2020, wherein Plaintiff discussed possible next steps in this case, by **Monday, May 11, 2020**, Plaintiff is ordered to file a letter stating whether intends to (i) withdraw its pending motion to dismiss counterclaims (ECF No. 67) and file a motion for sanctions, including dispositive sanctions; or (ii) since Mr. Oskouie insisted

that he has no additional discovery to produce, file a motion for default against the entity defendants and motion summary judgment against Mr. Oskouie; or (iii) move the case forward in some other fashion.

In light of his location in Iran, the Court reminds Mr. Oskouie that he may register with the Court to be an ECF Receiving User (one who receives email notifications of case activity) by submitting the Consent & Registration Form to Receive Documents Electronically. Mr. Oskouie should note that if he becomes a Receiving User, he must continue to submit filings in paper form. Magistrate Judge Henry B. Pitman ruled on Plaintiff's Letter-Motion at ECF No. 147 on May 3, 2018 (ECF No. 148). The Clerk of Court is respectfully directed to close ECF No. 147 and mail a copy of this order and a Pro Se (Nonprisoner) Consent & Registration Form to Receive Documents Electronically to Mr. Oskouie at the address below.
