
Dear Judge Pitman,

I am writing to request a three-week extension on Defendants' renewed motion for a stay in order to schedule and take the deposition of Defendant Oskouie's doctor via video conferencing. As the attached Certification of Mr. Oskouie demonstrates, it appears that, rather than send Oskouie his test results, they send their general information packet on leukemia and told him it was something else. According to the Doctor, his staff was concerned about sending out the actual results because they were getting threatening calls regarding Mr. Oskouie and these results. We would like the doctor to testify as to these events and all aspects of his cancer, including, if needed, how he came to the diagnosis. This deposition will clarify all the issues concerning Oskouie's illness, request for an extension, and demonstrate he did not knowingly put false information in front of the Court, and that his statements concerning his cancer are true.

Unlike Plaintiff, who have yet to retract the fraudulent affidavit they put in on the prior

motion for a stay, or even acknowledge its falsity, Oskouie wishes to clarify the evidence and provide all relevant information to the Court. Plaintiff has opposed this extension.
