
Re: BMaddox Enterprises LLC v. Oskouie, et. al. 17 Cv. 1889 (RA)

Dear Judge Pitman,

It has come to my attention that Plaintiff has filed, over a month after its motion for sanctions is *sub judice* and subsequent to my motion to be relieved as counsel (perhaps in the hope it would go unchallenged), and apparently without leave of Court. Plaintiff had the opportunity to brief his motion and put his best argument forward and file an additional brief in response to Defendants' opposition and availed itself of that opportunity. The Federal Rules do not provide for it to have yet a third bite at the apple, and one that cannot be challenged. This filing is precisely why Defendants' also moved for sanctions for the malicious, harassing actions of Plaintiff and its counsel. Plaintiff, by this filing, is in direct violation of the Federal Rules and the rules of this Court. It should not be accepted.

Given that this filing is violative of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, extremely untimely, and was done without leave of court, Defendants' respectfully request that the filings be struck.
