Before taking client's instructions GF explains and advises: her role: she is independent of police; here to protect and assert the client's interest and rights ; her status : qualified solicitor; police station advice is free of charge; define all elements of the offence(s); explain the Caution; inform client of allegation and what information was disclosed to GF: client was initially reluctant to give instructions. He expressed an interest however, in receiving a Police Caution, but wished to wait to see what new evidence the police had. GF advised that he would not be offered a caution, if he gave a no comment interview. If he had committed those offences alleged, he should be candid and answer the questions put.

Advice and Reason for Advice *Client had no plausible defence and therefore advised to answer questions admitting the offence in order to receive a Police Caution, if not maximise his credit in advance of a guilty plea*

Interview Summary

- Introduction of every person present in the interview room.
- Rights, & entitlements and Caution read out in full and explained.

Client was asked further questions relating to the offence he had been arrested for. Client answered questions, now admitting that he had placed those disparaging statements and pictures on the STD website. C stated he was going through a lot of stress. He recognised it was no excuse for his conduct and expressed sincere regret.

Client is asked to sign the CD seal forms.

POST INTERVIEW CONSULTATION:

Explained that police would need to make a decision about case.

Following outcomes 1) Charge 2) BTR 3) NFA [4) Caution]
